The harpoon portion of the Eastern Canada swordfish fishery has earned certification under the <u>Marine Stewardship Council</u>

(MSC) standard for sustainable and well-managed fisheries. The Canadian swordfish harpoon fishery occurs both within domestic waters and in international waters beyond the Canadian Extended Economic Zone. This is the first swordfish fishery in the world to earn MSC certification.
